

Pocket Doors and Kits

Pocket doors are not a new innovation, having first appeared in the 1850's, but in more recent times have seen a resurgence in popularity. Notorious issues of the past, such as doors falling off tracks and squeaky tracks and runners, have been overcome through modern design and technology.

The trend for open plan living and desire to maximise internal space has fuelled the demand for pocket doors, which offer a solution to save space and seamlessly open up areas or quickly shut off rooms.

Specification

To get the right pocket door solution for any property you must:

- Specify the right pocket door kit
- Specify the right pocket door design

The following pages contain the steps to achieving this.



Eight steps to specifying pocket door kits

Identify pocket door type

Do you require a single door or pair of double doors?

Structural opening

What is the width and height? Is there enough for both pocket and door leaf?

Finished wall thickness

Choose the right kit for your wall thickness, e.g. 100mm, 120mm

Door size

Do you require a kit for a single door or pair of double doors?

Standard or fire rated

Does your kit / door need to be FD30 fire rated?

Aesthetics

Select the best kit for your prefered design, with or without architrave

Technical requirements

Check the kit can handle the door weight. Ensure door size has factored the level of flooring

Accessories

Do you require soft close, door closing or synchronised pair opening?

Six steps when specifying pocket door design

- Door design, veneer and stain

 Typically, these are determined by the design of other doors in the property
- What pocket door system has been chosen?
 The design must meet the technical requirements of the kit and structural opening
- Consider cost implications

 The combined cost of the kit, installation, doors and ironmongery will be considerably more than a hinged door
- Consider suitability of door model & bead detail Make sure the beading is flush or recessed
- Check fire rating requirements

 If FD30, the door and kit must both be rated to the same standard
- Select flush pulls and ironmongery
 Choose the design and finish of your handles and ironmongery for a quality finish


